# 1. Minutes of Previous Meeting

The Minutes of the last meeting were read and signed as correct.

### 2. Burial Ground

The Chairman said that he had approached Mr Whitehead concerning the piece of ground suggested and he would be willing to sell the piece adjoining the present cemetery for £35. It was agreed that Mr Cole and the Hon. Clerk should meet Mr Whitehead, measure the piece of land concerned and that the Hon. Clerk should proceed with the necessary formality.

# 3. Bus Services

A letter from NRDC was then read and concerned the convenience of bus services in rural areas and the Hon. Clerk was asked to get full information from people using the buses particularly in connection with visiting hospitals and children attending schools in Soham or Ely.

### 4. Road Complaints (Water)

A further complaint was received about the waste water which oozes through the ground in several places, causing a most offensive smell and appearing to be much worse after rain. The council decided that NRDC should be informed on this matter and asked if they would help as Mr Housden would be willing to meet the Sanitary Inspector and show him the places where the trouble occurred.

## 5. Council Lettings

The question of the letting of the pit at the back of the Council Houses was brought up and the Hon. Clerk was asked to see the Clerk of Swaffham Prior Parish Council to get full information concerning this or any other land.
