1. Minutes of Previous Meeting

The Minutes of the last meeting were read and signed as correct.

2. Matters Arising

Mr Harrison reported that as a result of a personal incident he had spoken on the telephone to Mr Kisby about the state of the grass verges between villages. The Clerk read out a letter from Mr Kisby in which we were advised that road junctions and sharp bends only would be attended to for visibility purposes. Having discussed the matter, the council instructed that the Clerk should again write to Mr Kisby (copy to G. Woollard) saying that whilst we appreciate cut-backs have to be effected, no evidence could be seen within the village of work gangs having done any grass cutting and the situation in some areas is now becoming urgent and badly in need of attention.

3. Any Other Business

Mr Harrison agreed to speak to G. Woollard re moving the electricity pole in Great Lane.

The Chairman reported that Newmarket Cycle Club were proposing to hold another cycle race later in the year and after discussion it was decided that the Clerk should write to them (copy to Cambridgeshire Constabulary) stating that the council and parishioners would prefer not to have another cycle race within the village, other than the one staged in association with Reach Fair celebrations.

Mrs Harrison said complaints have been received about the amount of noise coming from Mr Warrington's barn and also that it has been heard as late as 1.30am. The Clerk was instructed to write to Mr Warrington saying complaints have been made and asking him to endeavour to keep the noise down to a reasonable level and also finish at an earlier hour.

The Chairman reported that Mr Reed had started work on the old cemetery.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting closed.
