### 1. Minutes of Previous Meeting

The Minutes of the last meeting were read and signed as correct.

### 2. Matters Arising

The chairman reported that the hole in Hythe House had been repaired. Councillor Woollard advised that all the results to the street lighting questionnaire had not been received but that a decision would probably be made in the Autumn.

### 3. Correspondence

The Clerk read out a letter from Eastern Electricity wherein it stated that Street Lighting Energy and Maintenance charges would be increased by 9% plus VAT at the standard rate with effect from April 1<sup>st</sup> 1979.

### 4. Planning Application

Planning Application Ref: E/0238/79/LB (A. F. Dudley) was discussed at length and the Council's comments were noted and advised to the District Council.

### 5. Cheques

### 6. AOB [Any Other Business]

The Chairman reported that dogs are being allowed to roam the village both during the day and night. It was decided that a notice should be inserted in "Out of Reach" magazine reminding the public of their responsibilities and that it is a punishable offence.

**7. Election of Officers**

Owing to the fact that the Parish Council Elections have been postponed until late May, it was decided to hold the Election of Officers during the June meeting.

**8. Trees**

Mr Harrison reported that the quota of 40 trees has been planted.
