However, during the construction period (and again during the dismantling period), I have concerns about how traffic would affect the local highway and rights of way network. The applicant must state the routes for construction vehicles between the B1102 and the site and must demonstrate how other highway users are to be kept safe. I may require additional passing bays on approach roads and Rights of Way Officers may require improvements to the surface of byways or temporary closures. In addition, a planning condition will likely be required for before / after highway condition surveys with any damage to be repaired by the applicant within a fixed period.
